

Meeting of Charlbury Town Council held on Wednesday 24th September 2014 at 7.30pm in the Corner House.

At the meeting on September 22nd Mr Cox presented an update on progress toward provision of a community centre at the Spendlove site. Progress was encouraging with financial agreement with OCC and the Fire Brigade Fund progressing. Planning should be progressing as architects have been selected. There is unlikely to be a need for enabling development.

Is there sufficient space for this number to be provided allowing for turning space for forward exit? Otherwise no objection

	1. All walls on this building should be of natural stone and roofs of slate. This is a sensitive site in the heart of the Conservation area and needs to be considered accordingly. The wood as proposed is unacceptable and therefore it is objected to.

- f) Joint Chairs of the group to be invited to update Council on a regular basis
- g) Need to address local residents more directly
- h) Funding budget for precept consideration has been requested
- i) Agenda item to be changed to include Neighbourhood Forum.

Landfill costs for WODC are increasing as the percentage of recyclables drops. WODC have a map of areas – variable frequency and cost of cuts Better way being considered

10. To consider a possible request for 20 mph limits in Charlbury

Mr James introduced this topic following several representations having been made to him.

OCC previously had a programme for introducing such limits which has stalled in Oxford with Police apparently not being prepared to enforce. OCC to be asked to send an officer to a meeting to discuss this further.
