MINUTES of the Extraordinary Meeting of the Town Council

held on Wednesday 16th November 2022

1. Apologies for Absence were received from N Potter.

2. Declarations of Interest: none were received.

3. Traffic

a. To consider installation of zebra crossing on The Slade

A town-wide survey has been held on the installation of a zebra crossing on The Slade, near the primary school: 91% of respondents are in favour of a crossing.

OCC policy is to enable School Crossing Patrols to work until retirement where a zebra crossing is installed and then not be replaced.

Oxfordshire County Council has confirmed that the zebra crossing will cost £30,000 to install and if the Town Council is able to pay £15,000 towards the crossing, the County will have it matched funded.

It was **resolved** to proceed with the installation of the zebra crossing in principle, subject to the funds being found in the budget. (proposed and seconded: JS and TC) The clerk will request that OCC puts it into the Traffic Regulation Order with the 20mph speed limit (also consulted on recently).

4. Community

a. To approve cost of printing cost-of-living flyers at £120

This was approved.

5. Buildings

a. To approve cost of printing buildings working group information session flyers and posters at £150

£170 was approved in case double -sided flyers were required.
