- The bottom of Watery Lane
- Dyers Hill – where the bench is (Church Lane)
- Hughes Close behind the memorial stones opposite Londis – exact area to be decided
- Mill Lane – by the telegraph pole

We are mindful of grass cutting schedules and as these would be narcissus, that would coincide with the first cut in April.

I'm sure you agree that the existing bulbs really make a difference to the appearance of the town. Any costs would be borne by the Garden Society.
