There is a healthy account balance due to improved bookings, particularly in the Corner House, and received donations from Street Fair and the Jubilee Barn Dance. The charitys' income over the past six months has been sufficient to cover its expenses and, along with the existing balance, a significant amount of maintenance work. All Corner House rooms with the exception of the Morris Room are providing continuous income and the occupants have accepted the recent 20% increase in room rates. There is underutilisation in the Memorial Hall unfortunately, and an article has been prepared for the next edition of the Chronicle describing how the recent renovation programme has improved the facilities available in the Memorial Hall.

## Resolution of the Trustees of Charlbury Corner House & War Memorial Charity

The resolutions were passed at the Trustees meeting on 13th July as follows:

The Trustees have resolved to merge the Corner House Charity with the CIO, which will result in the transfer of all the property of the Corner House Charity to the CIO.

The Trustees have resolved to request Charlbury Town Council as custodian trustee to execute any documentation that might be necessary to record that the Town Council will henceforth hold the Corner House and Memorial Hall for the CIO.

The Trustees have resolved to enter into the Vesting Agreement, which has been signed by all the Trustees of the Corner House Charity.

## Fibre broadband connection

Peter Kendrick has offered to continue in a liaison role for the CIO with negotiations with Gigaclear and OCCover the provision of fibre broadband to the Memorial Hall and the Corner House.
