Summary of decisions or actions requested (including timing): To consider removal of large waste areas and to supply wheelie bins	
Financial implications: Current costs are in region of £1000 pa Recommended costs would be circa £90 pa plus initial outlay to remove current rubbish and bin framework. Plus possible landscaping of area

Background:

The cemetery has 2 large rubbish areas – 1 at the boundary of the old and new cemeteries and 1 down the hill towards the northern extension.

The notice says green material only, however all types of rubbish are disposed of (beer cans, plastics etc).

Cotswold Landscaping currently hires a skip about twice a year to clear the rubbish. This includes sorting through it to ensure recyclables are recycled. The skip costs £400 per time plus a day's work for CL (circa £250)

Recommendation:

- CL to clear the rubbish one more time: £650 (they are doing this next week anyway as was agreed at the July meeting)
- CL to remove wooden framework of bins : £250
- Landscape area to prevent people still using the areas as bins: £?
- Notices to request people take their rubbish home with them (as at NA): £50
- Provide 3 garden waste bins from WODC: £90
- Provide recycling and grey bin from WODC
- Liz's friends to put the bins out for collection each week
- Provide wooden screen to place wheelie bins behind: £?
