

Proposal for Cemetery fees from 2025 to 2026

Please see table below which includes current fees and suggested fees for the next 2 years. You will see the comparison of current parochial fees as well.

Where the Charlbury fees are well over the parochial fees (memorials), I have not increased them.

Where the Charlbury fees are well under the parochial fees, I have increased them gradually to bring them into line (bearing in mind that the parochial fees increase slightly in January every year).

Certificate of Exclusive Rights aren't included in the parochial fees. Councils tend to charge the same fee for the certificate as they do for the burial but that is purely custom.

Ownership of an Exclusive Right of Burial does not imply ownership of the land itself or the right to carry out any particular activity on the grave plot. The owner does not own the land itself; the ownership of the cemetery land remains with the Council. However, the registered owner of the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial has the automatic right to be buried in the grave; and may also allow others to be buried in the grave (space permitting). This lasts for between 75 to 100 years. The plot then reverts to the council who can issue another Certificate of Ex Rights to (another) (but preferably the same) purchaser.
